



## Forge Cheat Sheet PDF

Install Forge CLI		
<b>Install the Forge CLI</b> <i>Install the <b>forge/cli</b> package on your system using npm</i>	1 npm install -g @forge/cli	<i>Install Node 20 or 22 before running this command</i>
<b>Login to the Forge CLI</b> <i>Log into your Atlassian account and start building with Forge</i>	1 forge login	<i>Generate an API token from your Atlassian account.</i>

  

The Development Lifecycle	
<b>Create a new App</b> <i>Create a new app based on a selected template and registers to your account</i>	1 forge create
<b>Deploy app to the cloud</b> <i>Deploy changes to your app to the cloud</i>	1 forge deploy
<b>Install your app to a cloud site</b> <i>Install your app to an Atlassian cloud site.</i>	1 forge install
<b>Start the forge development tunnel</b> <i>Start a development tunnel, allowing you to test local changes.</i>	1 forge tunnel

  

Test, Debug and Troubleshoot	
<b>Manage Storage</b> <i>Manage the storage for your app</i>	1 forge storage
<b>View Logs</b> <i>View the application logs</i>	1 forge logs
<b>Check code</b> <i>Checks the source for common errors</i>	1 forge lint
<b>Check and Fix code</b> <i>Check for common errors and attempt to automatically fix</i>	1 forge lint --fix
<b>Eligibility</b> <i>Check app is eligible for a particular program</i>	1 forge eligibility

Other useful commands	
<b>Register</b> <i>Register an app to your Atlassian Developer account</i>	<pre>1 forge register</pre>
<b>(Environment) Variables</b> <i>Manage your apps environment variables.</i>	<pre>1 forge variables [list set unset]</pre>
<b>Environments</b> <i>Manage app environments</i>	<pre>1 forge environments [list create delete]</pre>
<b>Install Forge autocomplete</b> <i>Install autocomplete for the Forge CLI</i>	<pre>1 forge autocomplete install</pre>
<b>Help</b> <i>Display help for the Forge CLI</i>	<pre>1 forge help</pre>
